Year 6 School Trips – Week Commencing 28th June

As you are aware, the coronavirus restrictions and risks meant we were unable to hold our residential trip this year. However, as restrictions are now easing we would like to attempt to replicate the fun they experience in Wales with a collection of exciting and action-filled day trips (Government restrictions allowing). These will take place towards the end of term and we are certain it will allow the children to finish their Cunningham Hill journey on a high note and make it a week to remember!

We are still awaiting confirmation on our other chosen venues but we are very excited to confirm the following are in the diary:

Thursday 1st July

We will make a big Cunningham splash at the 2012 Olympic White Water Centre at Lee Valley where we will have gallons of fun paddle-boarding, kayaking and tackling the inflatable wipe-out zone obstacle course.

Friday 2nd July

If Lee Valley doesn't provide enough fun then we are off to Hemel Hempstead Snow Centre, where each class will have a snowboard experience, a 'Slide and Try' session on inflatable rings and another activity still to be confirmed.

As you can see these activities will ensure the children have a great week and we are trying to compete with all the fun a residential trip would have offered.

Costs:

Whilst wanting to give the children the 'ultimate' week we are mindful of the costs but we expect the activities of the week to cost a maximum of £100. This cost will cover all entry, coach travel and insurances. We have put this on Parentmail for you to start contributing to, and if you are in receipt of Free School Meals, as with residential trips, the school will contribute a third of the cost.

If money is a restricting factor, please speak to us about financial support. Full payment is not required until 30th June, enabling the cost to be spread over the coming months which we hope will give enough time for these exciting trips for the children.

We will of course have coronavirus risk assessments for each trip, and all trips are dependent on national social distancing guidelines.
