Please make payment using your Parentmail account, go into the 'shop' and you will see the option to pay. Please also go into your 'Forms' on your account and complete the medical information and consent form.

**Please note if we do not receive enough contributions, this visit may be unable to go ahead for all children. Please speak to the Office if payment is a problem.*

This trip will not only enhance our passion for reading, but will be linked to the BookTrust's latest *Time to Read* campaign, when every child will receive a special pack containing the story book 'I am a Tiger' written by Karl Newson and illustrated by Ross Collins.
