Dear Year Five Parents,

St Albans Museum Trip – Tuesday 8th March 2022

We are delighted to be able to confirm details of our Year Five History trip to St Albans Museum, which will take place next week on Tuesday 8th March. This trip will compliment and extend our topic on Crime and Punishment.

During the morning, the children will be taking part in a re-enactment of a real Victorian court case, thus finding out how a court case would be carried out in Victorian times. After this, the museum staff will lead a further session in the learning studio. This will comprise of a reflection session on the trial they have just re-enacted as well as learning about more trials that happened there, along with questions around punishments fitting the crime and considering the context of the crimes in historic St Albans, with objects and documentary sources.

We will be walking to the museum and will be setting off shortly after 9am for a prompt start at the museum. We will return shortly after 12:45pm. Therefore, ALL children require a **packed lunch** as we will be eating when we return from the museum and have a slightly later lunch break. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals and you would like the school to provide a packed lunch please let the School Office know by Friday 4th March.

The children must wear school uniform, with a school cap.
