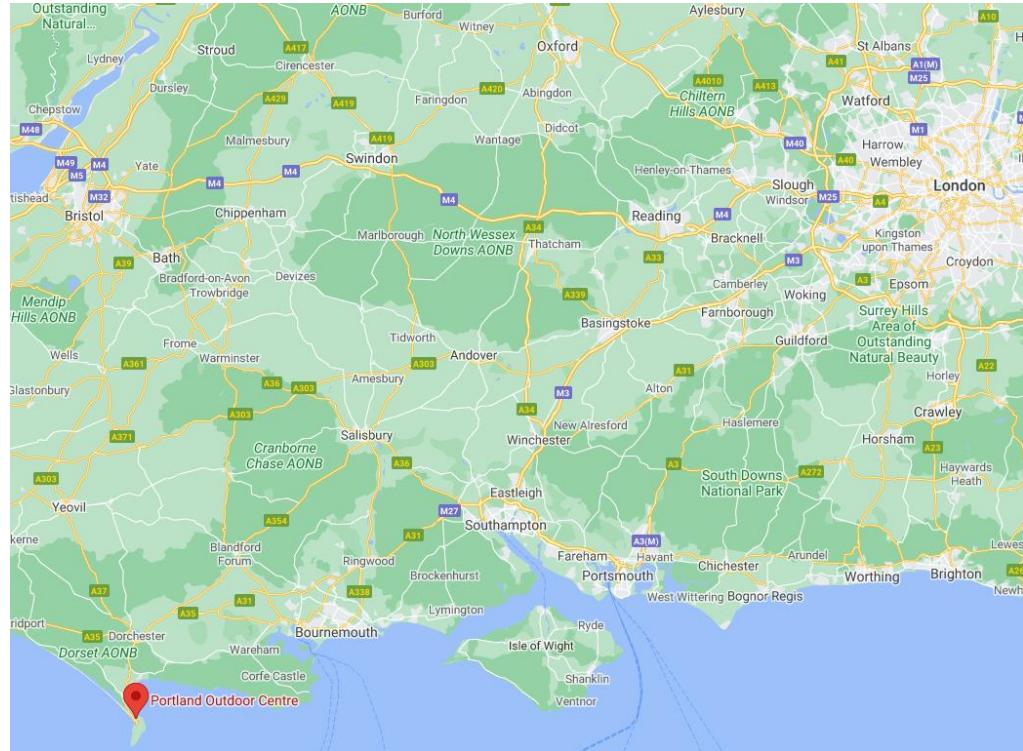
Portland Outdoor Centre, Dorset



Location

Portland Outdoor Centre is located on the Island of Portland, just south of Weymouth, Dorset. It is approximately a 3 hour drive from school.

The watersport activities will mostly take place in Portland Harbour, which is one of the largest man-made harbours in the world. It was also one of the venues for 2012 Olympics.



Accomodation

We will have exclusive use of the accommodation for the whole week. The rooms will consist of 4 or 6 beds and most of them are ensuite.
